# Joining SIC

To join SIC, one must undergo the Notification procedure.

The process includes ISO/IEC 17040 peer assessment.

Notification refers to the formal process where an organization's adherence to the System of International Certification (SIC System) and CASCO standards is validated.

Upon successful completion of this Notification procedure, the certification body is awarded a Notification Letter, serving as evidence of its membership within System of International Certification (SIC).



# Accreditation exchange & Cross-Marketing (Audit outsource)

The Accreditation Exchange Program allows for one CB to appoint auditors of a different CB to conduct work in compliance with specific accreditation sectors.

Control of the bodies participating in the accreditation exchange program is carried out in accordance with the mandatory document IAF MD 23:2023.

This allows all participants of the System to use the accreditations of other participants, which in turn will expand the circle of clients and the geography of the business.

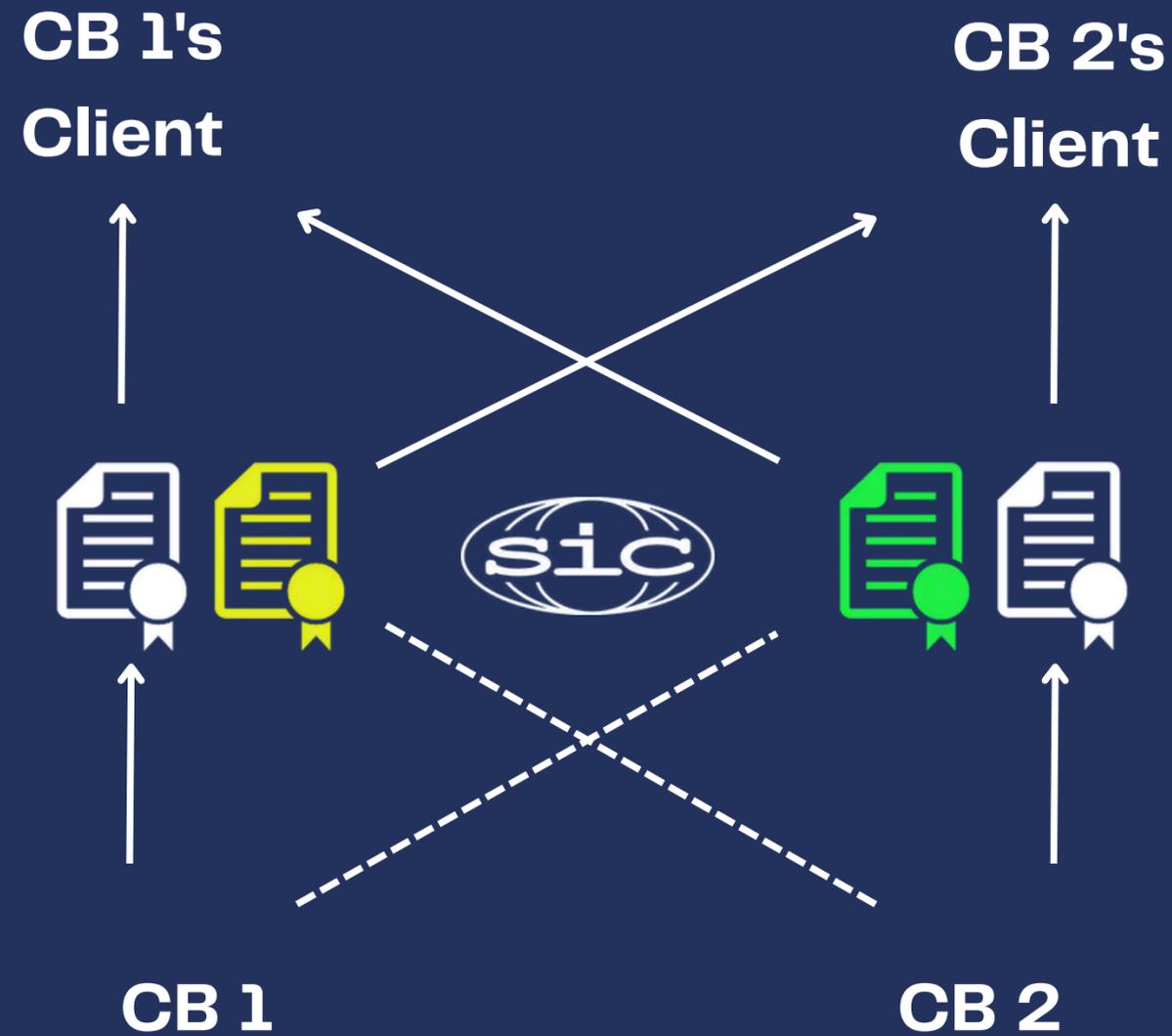

# Cross-Marketing Approach



## Enhanced Service Range & Client Value

By leveraging the cross-marketing feature, certification bodies can offer a wider range of ISO certifications to their clientele. Even if a certification body specializes in one set of standards, through cross-marketing, they can provide access to other standards held by associated bodies.

This means that your Certification Body can also offer its own standards and accredited certification to other members of SIC, where the associated CB carries out the audits on your behalf, and you in turn register and issue the certificate.

The body acting on behalf of the accredited body does not make decisions on issuing, refusing, maintaining, expanding or narrowing the scope of certification, as well as suspending, renewing or canceling the certification.

# Exchange of auditors with necessary experience

One auditor will not be able to cover all existing technical sectors, therefore SIC offers a solution in the form of a mutual auditor base.

Mutual auditor base means that each CB has the opportunity to hire other auditors within SIC for a particular audit that requires a particular qualification in the relevant technical industry in accordance with a specific standard.

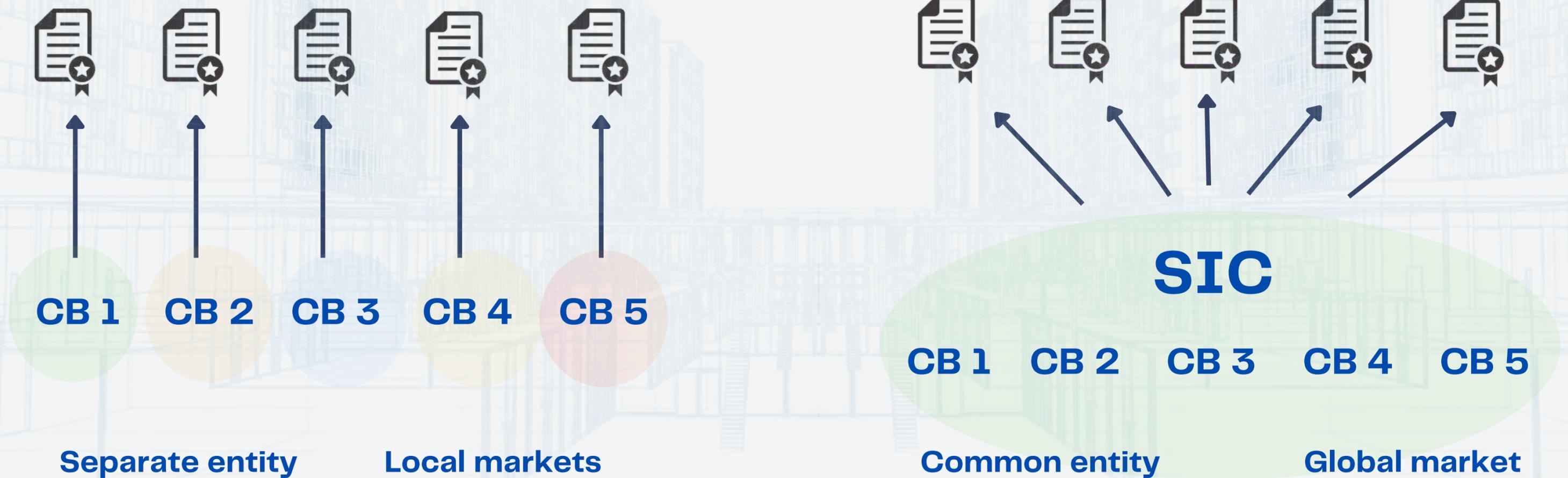

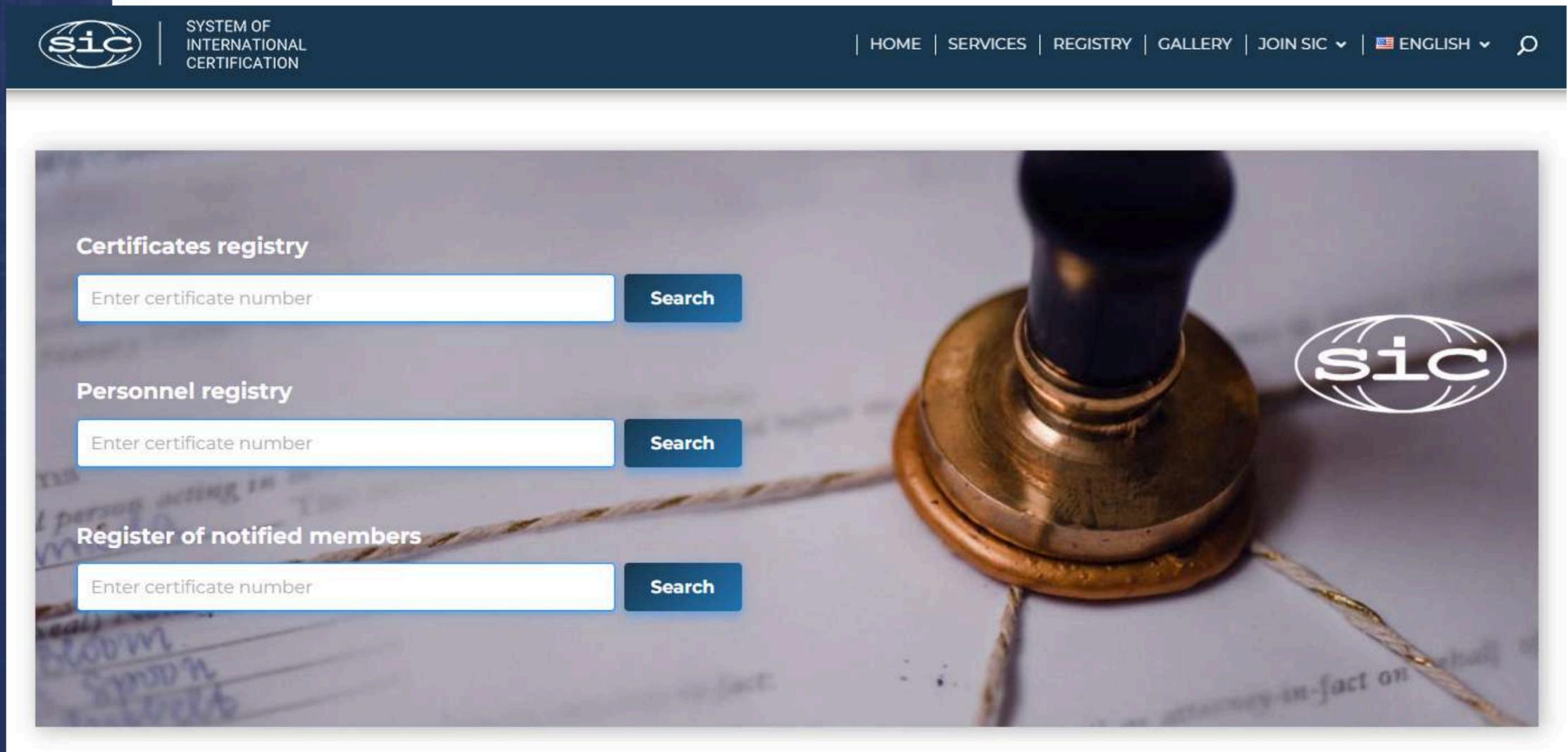
# REGISTRY
